ORDER EXTENDING THE CLAIMS OBJECTION DEADLINE TO MARCH 10, 2025

Upon the joint motion (the “Motion”)² of the Post-Effective Date Debtors and Alan D. Halperin, solely in his capacity as Claims Ombudsman, for the entry of an order (this “Order”) extending the deadline to object to Claims through and including March 10, 2025; and the Court having jurisdiction to consider the Motion and the relief requested therein pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; venue being proper before this Court; consideration of the Motion and the relief requested being a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b); due and proper notice of the Motion having been provided, and it appearing that no other or further notice need be provided; the Court having found and determined that the relief sought in the Motion is in the best interests of the Post-Effective Date Debtors’ estate, its creditors and all parties in interest, and that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Motion establish just cause for the relief granted herein; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor, it is hereby

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. That the Motion is GRANTED as set forth herein




2. That the Claims Objection Deadline shall be, and hereby is, extended through and including March 10, 2025 as to all Filed Claims, Scheduled Claims, and Administrative Claim Requests, including claims that are payable from the Administrative and Priority Claims Reserve; and it is further.

3. That this Order is without prejudice to the rights of the Post-Effective Date Debtors and the Claims Ombudsman to seek further extensions of the Claims Objection Deadline; and it is further.

4. That the Court shall retain jurisdiction to construe and enforce this Order.
