ORDER DIRECTING SUCCESSOR TRUSTEE TO PROVIDE CERTAIN INFORMATION  
AND DENYING BALANCE OF LETTER REQUEST FILED BY MR. COLT-SARMIENTO

On October 18, 2023, Mr. Alberto Colt-Sarmiento, who is incarcerated, filed a letter requesting that he be provided with the “License Profile; and entire credentials” of Yale Scott Bogen, the Successor Trustee of the JCK Legacy GUC Recovery Trust. Mr. Colt-Sarmiento also requested assistance in “sealing and classifying” all of his discovery. The Successor Trustee filed a response stating that all of the information detailing his credentials and qualifications for appointment as Successor Trustee was disclosed in the declaration accompanying the motion for his appointment. Further, Mr. Colt-Sarmiento’s objection to the motion for Mr. Bogen’s appointment of the Successor Trustee was overruled by the Court. The Trust further noted that Mr. Colt-Sarmiento is not a beneficiary of the GUC Recovery Trust and thus is not a party in interest with any pecuniary interest in the case.

A hearing on the letter request was held on November 8, 2023 at which the Court determined that because Mr. Colt-Sarmiento was incarcerated and it might be difficult for him to get access to material on file in the case, it might be preferable for the Successor Trustee to provide the requested information and the contact information by letter to Mr. Colt-Sarmiento.

With respect to Mr. Colt-Sarmiento’s request for protecting the confidentiality of certain information, the Court noted that although the movant was requesting the something get sealed,



the request was not clear as to what the movant was requesting get sealed or what was confidential or why. Therefore, the Court will deny that aspect of the request. Based upon the foregoing, it is hereby

ORDERED, that the Successor Trustee provide to Mr. Colt-Sarmiento by letter the Successor Trustee's credentials and contact information; and it is further

ORDERED, that the relief sought by Mr. Colt-Sarmiento with respect to sealing and classifying certain information is denied.
