**ORDER APPROVING SECOND INTERIM APPLICATIONS FOR ALLOWANCE  
OF COMPENSATION FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES RENDERED AND  
REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES INCURRED BY CULLEN AND DYKMAN LLP  
AS COUNSEL TO THE OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF UNSECURED CREDITORS OF  
MIDWEST CHRISTIAN VILLAGES INC. ET AL.**

Cullen and Dykman LLP (“C&D”), having filed its *Second Interim Application For Allowance Of Compensation For Professional Services Rendered And Reimbursement Of Expenses Incurred By Cullen And Dykman LLP As Counsel To The Official Committee Of Unsecured Creditors Of Midwest Christian Villages Inc., Et Al. For The Period From November 1, 2024 Through And Including February 28, 2025* (the “Application”)<sup>1</sup>; and the Court having reviewed the Application; and all applicable requirements of the Bankruptcy Code, the Bankruptcy Rules, and the Local Rules having been satisfied; and it appearing that the compensation earned and expenses incurred by C&D during the Compensation Period were actual, reasonable and necessary; and sufficient notice of the Application having been provided and no other or further notice being required; and all persons with standing having been afforded an opportunity to be heard on the Application at a hearing held to consider approval of the

Application; and upon all of the proceedings had before the Court and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that:

1. The Application is **APPROVED** as set forth herein.
2. C&D is allowed, on an interim basis, compensation in the amount of \$141,113.50 for professional services rendered during the Compensation Period as counsel to The Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors (the "Committee").
3. C&D is allowed the reimbursement of actual and necessary expenses incurred during the Compensation Period in connection with its services to the Debtors in the amount of \$176.59.
4. The Debtors are authorized and directed to remit payment to C&D in the amount of \$141,290.09, less all amounts that the Debtors previously paid to C&D on account of such fees and expenses.
5. Any payment made or to be made pursuant to this Order, and all authorization contained herein, shall be in compliance with and subject to the Final DIP Order [Docket No. 377] and the DIP Budget attached as Exhibit 1 thereto.
6. This Order shall be effective immediately upon entry.
7. Not later than two (2) business days after the date of this Order, C&D shall serve a copy of the Order and shall file a certificate of service no later than twenty-four (24) hours after service.
