- 2. On April 16, 2025, Debtor filed a Chapter 11 Plan of Reorganization ("the Plan.") ECF Doc. No. 254.

Tax Returns

- 3. Debtor has failed to file consumer use tax returns for the periods of February 2021, March 2021, June 2021, November 2021, April 2022, June 2022, and August 2022.
- 4. According to the records of the OTC, Debtor made payments for the above referenced periods. OTC is unable to determine whether Debtor may owe any additional liability associated with these tax periods until such returns have been filed and compared with the submitted payments.

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WHEREFORE, the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. Oklahoma Tax Commission, respectfully requests that the Court (1) order Debtor to file its missing tax returns prior to confirmation; and (2) OTC to be entitled to any other relief it is so justly entitled to.
