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NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

If you do not want the Court to grant the requested relief, or you wish to have your views considered, you must file a written response or objection to the requested relief with the Clerk of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Oklahoma, 215 Dean A. McGee Avenue, Oklahoma City, OK 73102 no later than 21 days from the date of filing of this request for relief. You should also serve a file-stamped copy of your response or objection to the undersigned movant's attorney [and others who are required to be served] and file a certificate of service with the Court. If no response or objection is timely filed, the Court may grant the requested relief without a hearing or further notice.

[Note – this is a flat twenty-one (21) days regardless of the manner of service.]
