# RESERVATION OF RIGHTS OF THE OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF UNSECURED CREDITORS TO CERTAIN OF THE DEBTORS' SECOND DAY MOTIONS

The official committee of unsecured creditors (the "Committee") of SC Healthcare Holding, LLC and its affiliated debtors and debtors-in-possession (the "Debtors") files this Reservation of Rights to the following (collectively, the "<u>Debtors' Motions</u>"):

- Debtors' Motion for Entry of Interim and Final Orders (I) Prohibiting Utility Companies from Discontinuing, Altering, or Refusing Service, (II) Deeming Utility Companies to Have Adequate Assurance of Future Payment, (III) Establishing Procedures for Resolving Requests for Additional Assurance, and (IV) Granting Related Relief [Docket No. 7];
- Debtors' Motion for Entry of an Order (I) Authorizing the Debtors to (A) Continue Insurance Coverage Entered Into Prepetition and Satisfy Prepetition Obligations Related Thereto, (B) Renew, Amend, Supplement, Extend, or Purchase Insurance Policies, (C) Honor the Terms of the Premium Financing Agreement and Pay Premiums Thereunder, (D) Enter Into New Premium Finance Agreements in the Ordinary Course of Business, and (E) Maintain the Surety Bonds; (II) Authorizing Banks to Honor and Process Check and Electronic Transfer Requests Related *Thereto; and (III) Granting Related Relief* [Docket No. 8];
- Debtors' Motion for Entry of an Order (I) Authorizing the Debtors to (A) Continue Insurance Coverage Entered Into Prepetition and Satisfy Prepetition Obligations Related Thereto, (B) Renew, Amend, Supplement, Extend, or Purchase Insurance Policies, (C) Honor the Terms of the Premium Financing Agreement and Pay Premiums Thereunder, (D) Enter Into New Premium Finance Agreements in the

- Debtors' Motion for Entry of Interim and Final Orders (I) Authorizing the Debtors to Pay Prepetition Claims of Certain Critical Vendors and (II) Granting Related Relief [Docket No. 26];
- Debtors' Motion for Entry of Interim and Final Orders (I) Authorizing the Debtors to (A) Pay Prepetition Wages, Salaries, Other Compensation, and Reimbursable Expenses and (B) Continue Employee Benefits Programs and (II) Granting Related Relief [Docket No 27];
- Debtors' Motion for Entry of Interim and Final Orders (I) Authorizing the Debtors to (A) Continue to Use Their Bank Accounts, (B) Honor Prepetition Obligations Related Thereto, (C) Maintain the Refund Programs, (D) Perform Intercompany Transactions, (E) Maintain Existing Business Forms; and (II) Granting Related Relief [Docket No. 41]; and
- Debtors' Motion for Entry of an Order (I) Extending the Time to File (A) Schedules and Statements and (B) Rule 2015.3 Financial Reports, (II) Modifying the Requirements for Filing Monthly Operating Reports, (III) Conditionally Modifying Deadlines for the Receivership Debtors, and (IV) Granting Related Relief [Docket No. 132].

The Committee states as follows:

#### **Objection**

- 1. On March 20, 2024 ("<u>Petition Date</u>"), the Debtors filed voluntary petitions for relief under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "<u>Bankruptcy Code</u>"). Under sections 1107 and 1108 of the Bankruptcy Code, the Debtors continue to operate their businesses as debtors in possession. No trustee or examiner has been appointed in these cases.
- 2. On April 9, 2024, the United States Trustee appointed the Committee, which consists of the following members: (i) Select Rehabilitation, LLC.; (ii) Martin Brothers Distributing Company, Inc.; (iii) Omnicare Inc.; (iv) McKesson Corporation; (v) Onestaff Medical, LLC; (vi) Lawrence Recruiting Specialists, Inc.; and (vii) Darlena Moore, as Independent Administrator of the Estate of Linda I. Johnson. [Docket No. 131].

3. The Committee was recently appointed and requires additional time to discuss with the Debtors the relief requested in the Debtors' Motions. The Committee reserves all rights with respect to the Debtors' Motions and expressly reserves and preserves all rights to raise any objections to the relief requested by the Debtors before any final hearing.
