ADDENDUM TO PROOF OF CLAIM OF MISSION CLOUD SERVICES, INC.

This Addendum is attached to and made part of the proof of claim (the "<u>Claim</u>") filed by Mission Cloud Services, Inc. ("<u>Mission</u>") against Plastiq, Inc. (the "<u>Debtor</u>") in the chapter 11 bankruptcy case *In re Plastiq Inc., et al* Case No. 23-10671 (BLS) (Bankr. D. Del.) (Jointly Administered)¹ pursuant to the Bar Date Order² and the Rejection Order (as defined herein). The Claim is evidenced by the Master Services Agreement (as defined herein).

Prior to the Petition Date, Mission and the Debtor entered into multiple contracts, including that certain Master Services Agreement dated as of October 1, 2019 (together with all schedules, purchase orders, invoices, amendments and addendums thereto, the "<u>Master Services Agreement</u>"). Pursuant to the Master Services Agreement, Mission provides certain services to the Debtor including, but not limited to, the provision of software and related software support. Mission continued to provide services to the Debtor pursuant to the Master Services Agreement post-petition and the Debtor has continued to pay amounts owed to Mission as they become due.

On October 16, 2023, the Court entered the Order Authorizing Rejection of Certain Executory Contracts, Effective As of September 25, 2023 [Docket No. 342] (the "<u>Rejection</u> Order"). The Rejection Order authorized the rejection of certain Mission contracts, including the Master Services Agreement. As a result of the Rejection Order, the Debtor informed Mission that it intends to terminate the Master Services Agreement effective as of November 30, 2023.

As of the date hereof, the Debtor has paid all outstanding amounts owed under the Master Services Agreement. However, the final invoice issued to the Debtor for November services will not become due and owing until December, well after the Rejection Damages Bar Date set to expire on November 15, 2023. As a result, out of an abundance of caution, Mission is filing this Claim for rejection damages in a contingent and unliquidated amount for any and all amounts owed as a result of the rejection of the Master Services Agreement, including amounts owed for services provided to the Debtor in November 2023. Furthermore, to the extent any additional amounts become due and owing, including any attorneys' fees and costs, and are not paid in the ordinary course, Mission hereby reserves any rights to compel the payment of such amounts as additional administrative expense claims. In the event that the Debtor pays all outstanding amounts owed to Mission in the ordinary course, Mission will withdraw this Claim.

Mission further expressly reserves all of its rights under the Master Services Agreement, the Bankruptcy Code and applicable law, and nothing herein shall affect Mission's rights under the same. Copies of certain supporting documents are voluminous and are available upon request.
