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By this Application, Parsons Behle & Latimer ("Parsons Behle" or the "Firm"), counsel to the above-captioned debtors and debtors in possession PolarityTE, Inc., a Delaware corporation ("PTE"), PolarityTE MD, Inc., a Nevada corporation ("PTE MD"), and PolarityTE, Inc., a Nevada corporation ("PTE NV" and, together with PTE and PTE MD, the "Debtors" or each a "Debtor"), under sections 328, 330 and 331 of title of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code"), Rules 2002(c)(2) and 2016 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (the "Bankruptcy Rules"), and the Guidelines for Applications for Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses promulgated by the Office of the United States Trustee (the "U.S. Trustee Guidelines"), hereby files its Final Fee Application (this "Application") seeking entry of an order, substantially in the form attached as Exhibit A hereto, (a) allowing and awarding on a final basis compensation for services rendered to the Debtors (i) for fees earned in the amount of \$15,156.00 and (ii) for reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses for expenses incurred in the amount of \$120.00, for a total allowed administrative priority expense claim in the amount of \$15,276.00 for the period of time between November 1, 2024 through February 26, 2025 (the "Compensation Period"); and (b) approving on a final basis all amounts included in Parsons Behle's First and Second Applications for Compensation (ECF Nos. 125, 172) (the "Prior Applications"). In support of the Application, the Debtors and Parsons Behle respectfully state as follows:

JURISDICTION

1. The Court has jurisdiction over this Application under 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334. Venue of this proceeding and this Application is proper in this district under 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409. The statutory predicates for the relief sought herein are sections 328(a), 330, and 331 of the Bankruptcy Code. This Application is a core proceeding under 28 U.S.C. 157.

2. The Debtors commenced these chapter 11 cases (the "Chapter 11 Cases") by

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each filing a voluntary petition for relief under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code on June 6, 2023 (the "**Petition Date**"). By final Order dated June 29, 2023, the Court approved joint administration of the Debtors' Chapter 11 Cases. No possessory trustee or examiner has been appointed in the Chapter 11 Cases. The Debtors continue to manage their assets as debtors and debtors in possession under sections 1107 and 1108 of the Bankruptcy Code. On July 31, 2023, the Court entered the Order approving the sale of substantially all of the Debtors' operating assets. (ECF 107). The Debtors' remaining assets consist of the cash proceeds of the sale and estate causes of action. The Debtors were able to close the sale quickly and without the need to obtain any post-petition financing, thus saving the estate any attendant administration expenses.

3. The Bankruptcy Court approved the Debtors' retention of Parsons Behle as its counsel on a final basis on June 29, 2023. (ECF 76.) The Debtors selected Parsons Behle because of its capabilities, and, in particular, its experience in restructuring, bankruptcy, and civil litigation.

4. The Debtors filed an Amended Chapter 11 Plan on August 15, 2024 (ECF 152) (the "**Amended Plan**") along with a Disclosure Statement (ECF 154) that was approved by the Court by Order on November 4, 2024 (ECF 166). The Amended Plan was confirmed by Order on January 27, 2025 (ECF 190).

PRIOR APPLICATIONS FOR COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT

5. Parsons Behle filed the Prior Applications seeking compensation and reimbursement of expenses on November 13, 2023 and November 22, 2024, respectively. (ECF Nos. 125, 172). Collectively, the Prior Applications sought fees in the amount of \$165,074.50 and reimbursement of expenses in the amount of \$7,193.34.

The Court granted Parsons Behle's Prior Applications on December 7, 2023 (ECF
138) and December 23, 2024 (ECF 181). Pursuant to the Court's Orders on the Prior Applications,

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Parsons Behle was awarded allowed administrative priority expense claims in the total amount of \$172,267.84 on an interim basis (the "**Prior Awards**").

PARSONS BEHLE'S PRESENT APPLICATION: FEES

7. Parsons Behle provides herewith detail describing the tasks performed, and the time required to perform those tasks at <u>Exhibit B</u>. The time entry detail categorizes all time entries in accordance with the U.S. Trustee's Guidelines by task code.
