CALCULATION OF ALLOWABLE REJECTION DAMAGES

In support of its proof of claim, Providence Partners, LLC ("Providence") provides its calculation of allowable rejection damages under 11 U.S.C. § 502(b)(6) as follows:

Monthly Rent = \$8,210.42 Monthly Common Area Maintenance (CAM) Charge = \$296.03 Term Remaining on Lease as of Petition Date = 25 months

The Plan indicates that the Debtor will be rejecting the commercial real property lease with Providence as of the effective date of the Plan. Assuming the lease is rejected, Providence elects to calculate its rejection damages under the "one year" provision of § 502(b)(6)(A), beginning June 19, 2024, the date Debtor filed its voluntary petition.
