INTRODUCTION

Randall Newsome ADR and Consulting and Randall J. Newsome ("the Firm") as courtappointed mediator to The Roman Catholic Bishop of Oakland, a California corporation, and the debtor and debtor-in-possession (the "<u>Debtor</u>" or "<u>RCBO</u>"), respectfully submits this third interim application for allowance of compensation (the "Interim Application") for services performed for the Debtor for the period of January 1, 2025 through April 30, 2025 (the "Interim Fee Period") in the above-captioned Chapter 11 bankruptcy case (the "Bankruptcy Case").

The Firm seeks interim approval of its fees and expenses incurred during the Interim Fee Period totaling \$50,932.60. This sum represents compensation in the amount of \$49,600 for the total of 49.6 hours spent by the Firm for mediation services provided to the Debtor and \$1,332.60 in out-of-pocket expenses. The Firm has received a total of \$0 in payments for services during the Interim Fee Period. and therefore now requests \$50,932.60 be paid to the Firm.

This Interim Application is based upon the contents hereof. Attached as Exhibit A are time records detailing the amount of fees charged and hours worked by the Firm during the Interim Fee Period, as well as an itemization of out-of-pocket expenses sought. Attached is Exhibit B are the receipts for those expenses. In order to preserve and protect the confidentiality of the mediation, the time entries submitted are not as detailed as is customary in other kinds of fee applications.

BACKGROUND

General Background

On May 8, 2023 (the "Petition Date"), the Debtor filed its voluntary Chapter 11 petition commencing the Bankruptcy Case. The Debtor continues to operate its ministry and manage its assets and properties as a debtor in possession under sections 1107(a) and 1108 of the Bankruptcy Code. No trustee has been appointed in this Bankruptcy Case.

On May 23, 2023, the Office of the United States Trustee (the "US Trustee") filed its notice of appointment of an Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors (the "Committee") [Docket No. 58].

The Debtor is a corporation organized under the laws of the State of California. The Debtor conducts its civil affairs under the laws of the State of California and the United States of America and in accordance with the Code of Canon Law, the ecclesiastical law of the Roman Catholic Church. Additional information regarding the Debtor, its mission, ministries, and operations, and the events and circumstances preceding the Petition Date, is set forth in the *Declaration of Charles* Moore, Managing Director of Alvarez & Marsal North America, LLC, Proposed Restructuring Advisor to the Roman Catholic Bishop of Oakland, in Support of Chapter 11 Petition and First Day Pleadings [Docket No. 19], which is incorporated herein by reference.

Employment of Randall Newsome ADR and Consulting LLC

On January 16, 2024 Randall J. Newsome filed his declaration of disinterestedness with the Court. Pursuant to a January 17, 2024 hearing, on January 22, 2024 the Court entered its order appointing Randall J. Newsome as one of four mediators in this case and referring the parties to mediation.

Summary of Mediation Services

During the relevant period of this application, the Firm's time was devoted almost exclusively to exploring the possibilities of the debtor's insurers contributing money to the trust fund established by the Debtor's proposed plan of reorganization. These efforts included a twoday live mediation in San Francisco on February 24 and 25, 2025. As of the date of this application, efforts to reach settlements with the Debtor's insurers are ongoing. No time has been charged for travel or preparation of this application.

REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES

This application seeks reimbursement of expenses of \$1,332.60 arising from the live twoday mediation session that took place in San Francisco on February 24 and 25, 2025. In addition to the expenses included in Exhibit B, Judge Newsome also incurred mileage costs of \$162.40¹ and tolls of \$16.00.

Additionally, this Interim Application is available from the claims and noticing agent, KCC, at no charge.

No Agreements to Share Compensation

The firm has no agreement or understanding of any kind or nature to divide, pay over, or share any portion of the fees to be awarded to it with any other person or attorney.

The Firm believes that the services rendered for which compensation is sought in this Interim Application have been beneficial to the estate and that the sums requested for the services rendered are fair and reasonable.
