and is sufficient under the circumstances; and the Court finding the relief requested in the Motion is in the best interests of the Debtor, its creditors, and other parties in interest; and after due deliberation and good cause appearing therefor,

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The Motion is granted as set forth herein.
- 2. Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1452 and Bankruptcy Rules 9006(b)(1) and 9027(a), the Removal Period during which the Debtor may file notices of removal of claims or causes of action in a civil proceeding is extended through and including January 30, 2026.
- 3. The Debtor is authorized to take all actions necessary or appropriate to effectuate the relief granted in this Order.
- 4. This Order shall be without prejudice to (a) any position the Debtor or Committee may take regarding whether section 362 of the Bankruptcy Code applies to stay any litigation pending against the Debtor, (b) the right of the Committee or any other party to oppose removal of any particular action or actions, or (c) the Debtor's right to seek further extensions of the Removal Period, or the Committee's right to oppose any such request.
- 5. Notwithstanding entry of this Order, nothing herein shall create, nor is it intended to create, any rights in favor of or enhance the status of any claim held by, any party.
- 6. This Court shall retain jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the implementation of or interpretation of this Order.
