BARNES & THORNBURG LLP'S TWELFTH MONTHLY FEE STATEMENT FOR THE PERIOD AUGUST 1, 2025 THROUGH AUGUST 31, 2025

Barnes & Thornburg LLP ("B&T") submits, pursuant to the Order Granting the Motion of the Debtors to Establish Procedures for Interim Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses for Professionals (the "Interim Compensation Order") (ECF No. 264) entered on October 14, 2024, this monthly fee statement for the payment of interim compensation rendered and reimbursement of expenses incurred during the period from August 1, 2025, through August 31, 2025, inclusive (the "Twelfth Monthly Fee Statement").
