**CERTIFICATION OF JEFFREY MILLER REGARDING THE
SOLICITATION OF VOTES AND TABULATION OF BALLOTS CAST ON
THE FIRST AMENDED JOINT CHAPTER 11 PLAN OF LIQUIDATION
FOR RHODIUM ENCORE LLC AND ITS DEBTOR AFFILIATES
PROPOSED BY DEBTORS AND AD HOC GROUP OF SAFE PARTIES**

I, Jeffrey Miller, declare, under the penalty of perjury, that the following is true and correct:

1. I am a Managing Director of Corporate Restructuring Services, employed by Kurtzman Carson Consultants LLC dba Verita Global (“**Verita**”), located at 222 N. Pacific Coast Highway, 3rd Floor, El Segundo, California 90245. I am over the age of 18 and not a party to these proceedings.

2. I submit this Voting Certification (the “**Certification**”) with respect to the solicitation of votes and the tabulation of Ballots cast on the *First Amended Joint Chapter 11 Plan of Liquidation for Rhodium Encore LLC and Its Affiliated Debtors Proposed by Debtors and Ad Hoc Group of Safe Parties* [Docket No. 1821] (the “**Plan**”).² Except as otherwise noted, all facts

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set forth herein are based on my personal knowledge, knowledge that I acquired from individuals under my supervision, and my review of relevant documents. I am authorized to submit this Certification on behalf of Verita. If I were called to testify, I could and would testify competently as to the facts set forth herein.

3. On August 29, 2024, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Texas (the “**Court**”) entered the *Order Authorizing the Employment and Retention of Kurtzman Carson Consultants, LLC dba Verita Global as Claims, Noticing, and Solicitation Agent* [Docket No. 43] (the “**Retention Order**”), authorizing Verita’s retention as the claims, noticing, and solicitation agent of the Debtors. The Retention Order authorizes Verita to assist the Debtors with, among other things, the service of solicitation materials and tabulation of votes cast to accept or reject the Plan. Verita and its employees have considerable experience in soliciting and tabulating votes to accept or reject proposed Chapter 11 plans.

A. Service and Transmittal of Solicitation Packages and Related Materials

4. On October 21, 2025 the Court entered the Pursuant to the *Order (A) Conditionally Approving the Adequacy of the Disclosure Statement; (B) Approving the Solicitation Procedures and Solicitation Packages; (C) Scheduling a Combined Hearing; (D) Establishing Procedures for Objecting to the Plan and Final Approval of the Disclosure Statement; (E) Approving the Form, Manner, and Sufficiency of Notice of the Combined Hearing; and (F) Granting Related Relief* [Docket No. 1834] (the “**Disclosure Statement Order**”). The Disclosure Statement Order established, among other things, (i) October 10, 2025 as the record date (the “**Voting Record Date**”) for determining the Holders of Claims and Interests entitled to vote on the Plan, (ii) procedures for the solicitation of votes to accept or reject the Plan (the “**Solicitation Procedures**”) and (iii) procedures for the tabulation of Ballots (the “**Tabulation Procedures**”). Pursuant to the

Plan and the Solicitation Procedures, only holders of Claims or Interests as of the Voting Record Date in the following classes were entitled to vote to accept or reject the Plan (collectively, the “Voting Classes”):

No other classes were entitled to vote on the Plan.

5. In accordance with the Solicitation Procedures, Verita worked closely with the Debtors and their advisors to identify the Holders of Claims or Interests entitled to vote, and on October 24, 2025, Verita caused the Solicitation Packages to be served on all known Holders of Claims or Interests entitled to vote on the Plan as of the Voting Record Date.

6. On October 24, 2025, Verita also caused the Notice of Non-Voting Status and Release Opt-Out Form and the Combined Hearing Notice to be served, in lieu of a Solicitation Package, on all known Non-Voting Holders as of the Voting Record Date in the following classes (which were not entitled to vote on the Plan): 1, 2, 3, 4, 5a, 5b, 7, 9

7. Furthermore, on October 24, 2025, Verita caused the Combined Hearing Notice to be served on the creditor matrix and all other parties required to receive such notice pursuant to the Disclosure Statement Order.

8. In accordance with the Disclosure Statement Order, neither a Solicitation Package, Notice of Non-Voting Status and Release Opt-Out Form, nor other Plan-related materials were distributed to holders of Claims or Interests in Class 8 (Intercompany Claims) or Class 12 (Intercompany Interests).

9. A certificate of service evidencing distribution of the foregoing materials was filed with the Court at Docket No. 1984. During the voting period, Verita forwarded materials to parties whose packages were returned with a forwarding address. A supplemental certificate of service evidencing the foregoing was filed with the Court at Docket No. 2003.

10. On October 24, 2025, Verita also posted links to the electronic versions of the Plan, the Disclosure Statement, the Disclosure Statement Order (excluding exhibits thereto), and the Combined Hearing Notice on the public access website at www.veritaglobal.net/Rhodium.

11. On October 27, 2025, the Combined Hearing Notice was published in *The New York Times*. An affidavit evidencing the foregoing was filed on November 4, 2025 [Docket No. 1961].

B. The Tabulation Process

12. Verita worked closely with the Debtors' advisors to create a voting database reflecting the names and addresses of holders of Claims and Interests, the classification of Claims and Interests, and voting amounts for the Voting Classes. In so doing, Verita relied on, among other things, the following information:

- a. the Debtors' Schedules of Assets and Liabilities;
- b. the claims information reflected on the register of filed proofs of claim, to identify and solicit holders of Claims and Interests in the Voting Classes; and
- c. the interest holders register maintained by Debtors as of the Voting Record Date to identify the holders of Class 10 (Common Interests) and holders of Class 11 (Imperium Interests) entitled to vote to accept or reject the Plan.

13. In accordance with the Solicitation Procedures, Verita received, reviewed, determined the validity of, and tabulated the Ballots submitted to vote on the Plan. Each Ballot submitted to Verita was date-stamped, scanned (if submitted on paper), assigned a Ballot number, entered into Verita's voting database, and processed in accordance with the Solicitation Procedures. To be included in the tabulation results as valid, a Ballot must have been (a) properly completed pursuant to the Solicitation Procedures, (b) executed by the relevant Holder entitled to vote on the Plan (or such Holder's authorized representative), (c) returned to Verita via an approved method of delivery set forth in the Solicitation Procedures unless the delivery method requirement was waived by the Debtors, and (d) received by Verita on or before the Voting Deadline (i.e., November 21, 2025 at 5:00 p.m. (prevailing Central Time)), which was established by the Disclosure Statement Order.

14. All valid Ballots cast by Holders entitled to vote in the Voting Classes and received by Verita on or before the Voting Deadline or, in the case of any Ballots with deficiencies, to the

extent such deficiencies were waived by the Debtors, were tabulated pursuant to the Solicitation Procedures.

C. Tabulation Results

15. The final tabulation of votes cast by timely and properly completed Ballots received by Verita is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**. The detailed Ballot reports for all Voting Classes are attached hereto as **Exhibit A-1** through **Exhibit A-3**.

16. A report of the Ballots excluded from the final tabulation is attached hereto as **Exhibit B**, along with the reason for exclusion.

D. Opt-Out Election

17. Verita reviewed and documented which holders of Claims elected to opt out of the Releases. A report of all Holders who elected to opt out of the releases contained in Article 10.5(c) of the Plan is attached hereto as **Exhibit C**. For the avoidance of doubt, this Voting Certification does not certify the validity or enforceability of any opt-out elections received, including those reported on **Exhibit C**, but rather is providing these opt-out election results for reporting and informational purposes only.

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E. Conclusion

18. To the best of my knowledge, information, and belief, I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing information concerning the distribution, submission, and tabulation of Ballots in connection with the Plan is true and correct.
