REORGANIZED DEBTORS' OBJECTION TO PROOF OF CLAIM NO. 1253 FILED BY FRANCHISE TAX BOARD

THIS IS AN OBJECTION TO YOUR CLAIM. THIS OBJECTION ASKS THE COURT TO DISALLOW THE CLAIM THAT YOU FILED IN THIS BANKRUPTCY CASE. YOU SHOULD IMMEDIATELY CONTACT THE OBJECTING PARTY TO RESOLVE THE DISPUTE. IF YOU DO NOT FILE A RESPONSE WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER THE OBJECTION WAS SERVED ON YOU, YOUR CLAIM MAY BE DISALLOWED WITHOUT A HEARING.

SpeedCast International Limited and its affiliates in the above-captioned chapter 11 cases (collectively, the "**Debtors**" and, as reorganized, the "**Reorganized Debtors**"), file this objection (this "**Objection**"), pursuant to sections 105(a) and 502(b) of title 11 of the United States Code (the "**Bankruptcy Code**"), Rule 3007 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (the "**Bankruptcy Rules**") and Rule 3007-1 of the Bankruptcy Local Rules for the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Texas (the "**Bankruptcy Local Rules**"), and respectfully submit in support of the Objection the *Declaration of Michael Healy in Support of the Reorganized Debtors' Objection to Proof of Claim No. 1253 Filed by Franchise Tax Board*

attached hereto as <u>Exhibit A</u> (the "Healy Declaration"), and request entry of an order, substantially in the form attached hereto as <u>Exhibit B</u> (the "Proposed Order") disallowing Proof of Claim No. 1253 (the "FTB Claim") filed by the Franchise Tax Board ("FTB") against Speedcast Americas, Inc. ("Speedcast").

Jurisdiction

 This Court has jurisdiction to consider this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1334. This is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b). Venue is proper before this Court pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409.

Relief Requested

2. The FTB Claim was filed on August 10, 2020 and the support attached to the FTB Claim asserts a claim against Speedcast in respect to tax returns which were allegedly not filed by Speedcast. Following discussions between the Reorganized Debtors and the FTB, on March 1 2022, the FTB filed Proof of Claim No. 1516 (the "**Surviving Claim**"), which amended and superseded the FTB Claim.

3. Failure to disallow the FTB Claim would result in FTB receiving an unwarranted recovery against the Debtors under the *Third Amended Joint Chapter 11 Plan of SpeedCast International Limited and its Debtor Affiliates* (ECF No. 1394) (the "**Plan**").

4. Accordingly, the Reorganized Debtors respectfully request that the Court enter the Proposed Order disallowing the FTB Claim.

Reservation of Rights

5. This Objection is limited to the grounds stated herein and accordingly is without prejudice to the rights of the Reorganized Debtors or any other party in interest to object to any claim, including the FTB Claim, on any grounds whatsoever, and the Reorganized Debtors expressly reserve all other substantive or procedural objections that they may have. Nothing

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contained herein is intended to be or shall be deemed as (i) an admission as to the validity of any claim against the Debtors, (ii) a waiver of the Reorganized Debtors' or any appropriate party-ininterest's rights to dispute the amount of, basis for, or validity of any claim, (iii) a waiver of the Reorganized Debtors' or any other party-in-interest's rights under the Bankruptcy Code or any other applicable nonbankruptcy law, or (iv) an approval, adoption, assumption, or rejection of any agreement, contract, program, policy, or lease under section 365 of the Bankruptcy Code.

<u>Notice</u>

6. Notice of this Objection will be provided to (i) any party that has requested notice pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 2002, (ii) the affected claimant, and (iii) any other party entitled to notice pursuant to Bankruptcy Local Rule 9013-1(d).

<u>No Previous Request</u>

7. No previous request for the relief sought herein has been made by the Reorganized Debtors to this or any other court.

WHEREFORE the Reorganized Debtors respectfully request entry of the Proposed Order granting the relief requested herein and such other and further relief as the Court may deem just and appropriate.
