JOINT STIPULATION AND AGREED ORDER
REGARDING INTERNAL REVENUE SERVICE’S PROOFS OF CLAIM

The Department of Treasury – Internal Revenue Service (the “IRS”) and SpeedCast Americas, Inc. and Maritime Communication Services, Inc. (together, the “Reorganized Debtors”; and collectively with the IRS, the “Parties”) hereby enter into this *Stipulation and Agreed Order* with respect to the extension of the deadline for the Reorganized Debtors to object to the remaining unresolved claims asserted by the IRS against the Reorganized Debtors (the “Claim Objection Deadline”) and stipulate and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, on October 19, 2020 and July 17, 2023 the IRS filed proofs of claim numbers 1423 and 1520 respectively (the “Proofs of Claim”)²;

WHEREAS, on June 27, 2023, the Court entered the *Joint Stipulation and Agreed Order Regarding Internal Revenue Service’s Proofs of Claim* (Docket No. 2046), extending the Claim Objection Deadline for the Proofs of Claim to December 31, 2023;

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to further extend the Claim Objection Deadline to consensually resolve the Proofs of Claim.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS STIPULATED BY THE PARTIES AND HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Claim Objection Deadline is hereby extended through and including June 30, 2024 for the Proofs of Claim, also identified on **Schedule 1** attached to this Order and Stipulation.

2. This Stipulation and Order contains the entire agreement between the Parties as to its subject matter.

3. This Court retains jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters arising from, or related to, the implementation, interpretation, or enforcement of this Stipulation and Order.
