PLAN ADMINISTRATOR'S FIRST OMNIBUS (NON-SUBSTANTIVE)
OBJECTION TO CERTAIN PROOFS OF CLAIM

(Improperly Filed Claims)

THIS IS AN OBJECTION TO YOUR CLAIM. THIS OBJECTION ASKS THE COURT TO DISALLOW THE CLAIM THAT YOU FILED IN THIS BANKRUPTCY CASE. IF YOU DO NOT FILE A RESPONSE WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER THE OBJECTION WAS SERVED ON YOU, YOUR CLAIM MAY BE DISALLOWED WITHOUT A HEARING.

REPRESENTED PARTIES SHOULD ACT THROUGH THEIR ATTORNEY.

Steven Balasiano, in his capacity as Plan Administrator of Stage Stores, Inc. and Specialty Retailers, Inc. (together, the “Wind-Down Debtors,” and, prior to the Effective Date, as defined herein, the “Debtors”) hereby files this first omnibus (non-substantive) objection (this “Objection”) to certain proofs of claim pursuant to Section 502 of Title 11 of the United States Code (the “Bankruptcy Code”), Rules 3001 and 3007 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedures (the “Bankruptcy Rules”), and Rule 3007-1 of the Local Bankruptcy Rules of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Texas (the “Local Rules”) for entry of an order substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit D (the “Proposed Order”). support of the Objection, the Plan Administrator submits the Declaration of Douglas W. Squasoni of Saccullo Business Consulting, LLC attached hereto as Exhibit A (the “Squasoni Declaration”), and respectfully represents as follows:

JURISDICTION AND VENUE

1. This Court has jurisdiction to consider this Motion under 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334. This is a core proceeding under 28 U.S.C. § 157(b). This is a core proceeding within the meaning of 28 U.S.C. § 157(b). The Plan Administrator consents to entry of a final order under Article III of the United States Constitution.

2. Venue is proper in this district under 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409.

BACKGROUND

A. General Background

3. On May 10, 2020 (the “Petition Date”), each of the Debtors filed a voluntary petition for relief under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code with this Court.

4. Additional information about the Debtors’ business and the events leading up to the Petition Date can be found in the *Disclosure Statement for the Amended Joint Chapter 11 Plan of Stage Stores, Inc. and Specialty Retailers, Inc.* [Docket No. 535].

5. On August 13, 2020, the Debtors filed the *Joint Second Amended Chapter 11 Plan of Stage Stores, Inc. and Specialty Retailers, Inc.* [Docket No. 694] (the “Plan”).

6. On August 14, 2020, the Court entered the *Order Confirming the Joint Second Amended Chapter 11 Plan of Stage Stores, Inc. and Specialty Retailers, Inc.* [Docket No. 705] (the “Confirmation Order”).

7. The effective date of the Plan occurred on October 30, 2020 [Docket No. 898] (the “Effective Date”).

8. On the Effective Date, Steven Balasiano, in his capacity as Plan Administrator, became the sole representative of the Wind-Down Debtors' estates for the purpose of, *inter alia*, making or facilitating distributions contemplated under the Plan. *See* Plan Art.IV.D.

B. The Bar Dates

9. On June 18, 2020, the Court entered the *Order (I) Setting Bar Dates for Filing Proofs of Claim, Including Requests For Payment Under Section 503(b)(9), (ii) Establishing Amended Schedules Bar Date and Rejection Damages Bar Date, (iii) Approving the Form of and Manner for Filing Proofs of Claim, Including Section 503(b)(9) Requests, (iv) Approving Notice of Bar Dates, and (v) Granting Related Relief* [Docket No. 478] (the "Bar Date Order").

10. Among other things, the Bar Date Order established July 24, 2020 at 5:00 p.m. (prevailing Central Time) as the general date (the "Claims Bar Date") for creditors to file proofs of claim against the Debtors that arose prior to the Petition Date, including claims arising under section 503(b)(9) of the Bankruptcy Code ("503(b)(9) Claims").

11. The Bar Date Order required each entity asserting a prepetition claim against the Debtors to file an original, written proof of claim "substantially in the form attached to the Bar Date Order as Exhibit 1 (the "Proof of Claim Form") or Official Form 410." Bar Date Order ¶ 1. Copies of the Proof of Claim Form and Official Form 410 are annexed hereto as Exhibit B and Exhibit C, respectively.

12. The Proof of Claim Form provides that "[o]ther than a claim under 11 U.S.C. § 503(b)(9), this form should not be used to make a claim for an administrative expense arising after the commencement of the case." Exhibit B. Likewise, Official Form 410 provides: "[d]o not use this form to make a request for payment of an administrative expense. Make such a request according to 11 U.S.C. § 503." Exhibit C.

13. The Confirmation Order established (i) September 14, 2020 as the initial bar date for Administrative Claims² arising after the Petition Date through the date the Confirmation Order was entered (the “First Administrative Bar Date”), and (ii) November 30, 2020 as the final bar date for Administrative Claims arising on or after the date the Confirmation Order was entered but prior to the Effective Date (the “Final Administrative Bar Date” and together with the First Administrative Bar Date, the “Administrative Bar Dates”).

14. Both the Plan and Confirmation Order expressly provide that “requests for payment of Allowed Administrative Claims must be Filed and served on the Debtors or the Wind-Down Debtors no later than the Administrative Claims Bar Date. **Holders of Administrative Claims that are required to, but do not, File and serve a request for payment of such Administrative Claims by such date shall be forever barred, estopped, and enjoined from asserting such Administrative Claims against the Debtors or their property, and such Administrative Claims shall be deemed satisfied, settled, and released as of the Effective Date.**” Plan Art.II.A, Confirmation Order ¶ 119.

RELIEF REQUESTED

15. By this Objection, the Plan Administrator requests entry of the Proposed Order disallowing and expunging the portion of each proof of claim identified on Schedule 1 thereto in the column titled “Modified Claims” only to the extent such portion constitutes a postpetition administrative expense claim (such portions, the “Improper Form Claims”). The Improper Form Claims assert postpetition administrative expense claims against the Debtors and their estates. The Improper Form Claims were submitted to the Debtors’ claims agent, Kurtzman Carson Consultants

LLC (“KCC”), using a proof of claim form, and were not filed on the docket and served on the Debtors, as expressly required by the Plan and Confirmation Order.

16. Based on the Plan Administrator’s preliminary review, several of the Improper Form Claims appear (i) to be duplicative of timely filed motions for payment of administrative expenses that were properly filed on the docket in the accordance with the Plan and Confirmation Order *and/or* (ii) to have been already satisfied by the Debtors’ estates. However, in an effort to conserve limited estate resources, the Plan Administrator is filing this Objection to the Improper Claim Forms solely on the basis that such claims were improperly filed, and the Plan Administrator reserves his right to object to the Improper Form Claims on any other basis in the event this Objection is overruled in whole or in part.

17. For the avoidance of doubt, through this Objection, the Plan Administrator objects solely to the *postpetition* administrative portion of each proof of claim identified on Schedule 1 to the Proposed Order and seeks to leave the remaining portions of such claims unaffected, with all parties’ rights with respect thereto reserved.

BASIS FOR RELIEF

18. Bankruptcy Code Section 503 should be “strictly construed because administrative expense priority claims reduce the funds available for creditors and other claimants.” *City of White Plains v. A&S Galleria Real Estate, Inc. (In re Federated Dep’t Stores, Inc.)*, 270 F.3d 994, 1000 (6th Cir. 2001); *see also Howard Delivery Serv. v. Zurich Am. Ins. Co.*, 547 U.S. 651, 667, 669 (2006) (noting that administrative claims “must be tightly construed”); *In re ASARCO LLC*, No. 05-21207, 2010 WL 3812642 (Bankr. S.D. Tex. Sept. 28, 2010) (“priority statutes ... should be strictly construed to preserve the estate for the benefit of creditors”). Bankruptcy Code section 503(a) provides that “[a]n entity may timely file a request for payment of an administrative

expense.” An administrative expense will be allowed by the court only after notice and a hearing. *See* 11 U.S.C. § 503(b).

19. “The Fifth Circuit requires an application for post-petition administrative claims.” *In re Jack Kline Co., Inc.*, 440 B.R. 712, 732 (Bankr. S.D. Tex. 2010) (citing *NL Industries, Inc. v. GHR Energy Corp.*, 940 F.2d 957, 966 (5th Cir. 1991)). In *In re Taco Bueno Restaurants, Inc.*, the Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Texas recently held that administrative expense claims *cannot* be asserted through a proof of claim where the plan and confirmation order requires such claims to be filed pursuant to a motion. *See In re Taco Bueno Restaurants, Inc.*, 606 B.R. 289 (Bankr. N.D. Tex. 2019) (granting the Debtors’ motion to disallow administrative claims that were incorrectly asserted through a proof of claim form).

20. In reaching its decision, the *Taco Bueno* Court relied on four reasons: first, Official Claim Form 410 expressly provides that it is not to be used for requests for payment of administrative expenses. *Id.* at 301. Second, proofs of claim can solely be used to assert prepetition claims. *Id.* Third, pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 3001(f), proofs of claim have *prima facie* validity and, conversely, the claimant bears the burden of persuasion and production with respect to an administrative expense claim. *Id.* at 301-02. Fourth, the debtors had an interest in being able to quickly ascertain asserted administrative claims from the docket instead of the claims register. *Id.* at 302-03.

21. Here, like in *Taco Bueno*, the Plan and Confirmation Order required any party asserting a postpetition administrative expense request to file a motion on the docket by the applicable Administrative Claims Bar Date. *See* Plan Art.II.A; Confirmation Order ¶ 119. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the claimants on Schedule 1 asserted postpetition administrative expense claims against the Debtors’ estates by filing a proof of claim form with KCC. The proofs

of claim underlying each Improper Form Claim do not constitute a proper request for allowance and payment of a postpetition administrative expense pursuant to Bankruptcy Code section 503(a).

22. For the same reasons indicated in *Taco Bueno*, the Plan Administrator requests that the Court disallow and expunge each Improper Form Claim from the claims register. Critically, if the Improper Form Claims are not disallowed and expunged, the Wind-Down Debtors' other creditors will be prejudiced. At the outset of these cases, the Plan Administrator worked to develop a comprehensive claims reconciliation strategy and wind-down budget for the remaining estate assets. In doing so, the Plan Administrator assumed that all allowable, postpetition administrative expenses were those requests that were timely filed on the docket in advance of the applicable Administrative Bar Date—all of which have been resolved to date. If the Improper Form Claims are not disallowed and expunged, the Plan Administrator's review and reconciliation of prepetition unsecured priority and general unsecured claims will be delayed, and recoveries to such creditors may be diminished.

23. Accordingly, for the reasons set forth herein, the Plan Administrator respectfully requests entry of the Proposed Order disallowing and expunging the Improper Form Claims.

SEPARATE CONTESTED MATTER

24. This Objection to the Improper Form Claims constitutes a separate contested matter as contemplated by Bankruptcy Rule 9014. The Plan Administrator requests that any order entered by this Court with respect to an objection asserted herein shall be deemed a separate order with respect to each Improper Form Claim.

RESERVATION OF RIGHTS

25. The Plan Administrator expressly reserves the right to amend, modify or supplement this Objection and to file additional substantive or non-substantive objections to the

Improper Form Claims, or any other claims (filed or not) which may be asserted against the Debtors or Wind-Down Debtors, as applicable. In addition, the Plan Administrator reserves the right to seek further reduction of any claim for any reason including to the extent such claim has been paid, and further reserve the right to raise further objections.

COMPLIANCE WITH LOCAL RULES

26. This Objection includes citations to the applicable rules and statutory authorities upon which the relief requested herein is predicated, and a discussion of their application to this Objection. The Plan Administrator objects to no more than 100 proofs of claim herein. The Plan Administrator has served notice of this Objection on those persons whose names appear in the signature blocks on the Improper Form Claims, and in accordance with Bankruptcy Rule 7004. Finally, the Plan Administrator submits that this Objection satisfies Local Rule 3007-1.

NO PREVIOUS REQUEST

27. No previous request for the relief sought herein has been made by the Plan Administrator to this or any other court.

NOTICE

28. Notice of this Objection has been provided to the parties listed on Schedule 1 on those persons whose names appear in the signature blocks on the Improper Form Claims.

WHEREFORE, the Plan Administrator respectfully requests that the Court enter an order, substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit D, granting (i) the relief requested herein and (ii) such other and further relief as it deems just and proper.

FIRST OMNIBUS (NON-SUBSTANTIVE) OBJECTION TO CERTAIN PROOFS OF CLAIM**

I, Douglas W. Squasoni, hereby declare under penalty of perjury:

1. I am an employee of Saccullo Business Consulting, LLC ("SBC"). On or about November 4, 2020, SBC was retained by the Plan Administrator as a restructuring consultant to help facilitate the liquidation of the Wind-Down Debtors' remaining assets pursuant to the Plan and Confirmation Order. I have more than 26 years of experience in the restructuring industry, including many years of providing consulting and advisory services in post-confirmation chapter 11 cases.

2. I am generally familiar with the Debtors' books and records, and am overseeing the Plan Administrator's review and reconciliation of claims filed against the Debtors' estates.

3. I have read the Objection, filed contemporaneously herewith.

4. To the best of my knowledge, information, and belief, the assertions made in the Objection are accurate. In evaluating the Improper Form Claims, I have reviewed and overseen the review and analysis of the Wind-Down Debtors' books and records and the relevant proofs

of claim, as well as the supporting documentation provided by each claimant, and have determined that each Improper Form Claim should be disallowed and expunged. As such, I believe that the relief requested in the Objection is appropriate.

5. Based on my review, I have determined that each Improper Form Claim listed on Schedule 1 asserts a postpetition administrative expense claim against the Debtors' estates.

6. I understand that the failure to disallow and expunge the Improper Form Claims could result in the applicable claimants receiving an improper recovery on account of such claims, to the detriment of the Debtors' other, similarly situated creditors. As such, I believe that the disallowance of the Improper Form Claims on the terms set forth in the Objection is appropriate.

3. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained herein, nothing herein shall affect the validity, nature, amount, allowability, priority, or otherwise seek to reclassify, disallow, or expunge any prepetition claim, including a 503(B)(9) Claim, that may have been asserted by the claimants of the Improper Form Claims, including those amounts set forth in the “Modified Claims” column on Schedule 1 hereto. All parties’ rights are reserved with respect to the Modified Claims, including the Plan Administrator’s right to file a further objection and seek disallowance thereof.
4. The Plan Administrator’s rights to amend, modify, or supplement the Objection, to file additional objections to any claims (filed or not) asserted against the Wind-Down Debtors, and to seek further reduction of any claim to the extent such claim has been paid, are preserved. Additionally, should one or more grounds of objection stated in the Objection be overruled, the Plan Administrator’s rights to object on other stated grounds or on any other grounds that the Plan Administrator discovers are further preserved.
5. Notwithstanding any Bankruptcy Rule or Local Rule to the contrary, this Order shall be immediately effective and enforceable upon its entry.

6. This Court shall retain jurisdiction over any and all matters arising from the interpretation, implementation, or enforcement of this Order.
