ADDENDUM TO PROOF OF CLAIM

1. This is the Addendum to the proof of claim being submitted by Cintas Corporation (the “Claimant”). This Addendum is an integral part of the proof of claim and is incorporated by reference into the proof of claim for all purposes.

2. Upon information and belief, Claimant and the Debtor were parties to certain Agreement(s) (the “Agreements”) pursuant to which Claimant would provide Debtor certain goods and/or services.

3. On February 20, 2023, (the “Petition Date”), the Debtor filed a voluntary petition for relief under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the “Bankruptcy Code”) in the Court at the above-referenced case number.

4. On or about February 20, 2023, the Debtor filed its creditor matrix (the “Creditor Matrix”) [Doc. No. 24]. On the Creditor Matrix, the Debtor lists Claimant. Upon information and belief Claimant believes it is averred certain sums under the Agreement(s) between the Parties. Claimant is still gathering the information necessary to complete this proof of claim and therefore submits this claim for an undetermined amount. Claimant will amend this Claim once information is analyzed.

5. The Claimant reserves its rights, including, but not limited to, its rights of netting, recoupment, and setoff. The Claimant also reserves its rights regarding all other claims and/or defense that the Claimant may possess and/or assert against the Debtor.

6. The Claimant reserves the right to amend or supplement this proof of claim from time to time and at any time.
