## MOTION TO ALLOW LATE-FILED CLAIM

COMES NOW, Rhonda Major, a creditor in the above-captioned bankruptcy case, and respectfully moves this Court for entry of an order allowing my Proof of Claim as timely filed, and states as follows:

1. This Court entered an order establishing November 5, 2025 as the deadline for filing proofs of claim.
2. I completed and mailed my Proof of Claim (Official Form 410) on November 4, 2025, as evidenced by the U.S. Postal Service postmark (attached as Exhibit A).
3. Although my claim was mailed prior to the deadline, it may not have been received by the claims agent until after November 5, 2025.
4. Under Bankruptcy Rule 9006(b)(1), the Court may permit a late filing where the delay was the result of "excusable neglect." Mailing before the deadline with a timely postmark constitutes such excusable neglect, particularly as no prejudice will result to the Debtor or other creditors.
5. Accordingly, I respectfully request that the Court deem my Proof of Claim to be timely filed.

WHEREFORE, I respectfully request that the Court grant this Motion and allow my Proof of Claim as timely filed, and grant such other relief as is just and proper.

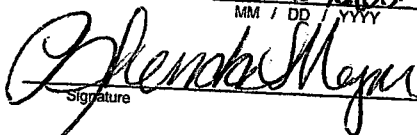

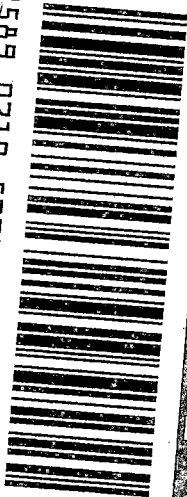

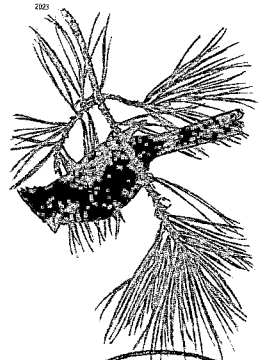
