

The Defendant agrees to plead guilty in the above-captioned cases as set forth below. The Defendant agrees to give up his 5th amendment right to refuse to testify and agrees to testify in the case of *State v. Lawrence Jackson* [named decedent Sherry Kang], in general accordance with the statements that he made to Detective Vincent Canales implicating and identifying Lawrence Jackson as the individual that shot and killed Sherry Kang and shot Young Macklin during the robbery that occurred on 4/26/02 at the 7 Market Grocery Store in Bladensburg, Md. The Defendant acknowledges that his statements to Detective Canales were freely and voluntarily made months prior to the initiation or discussion of any plea agreement. The State in return agrees to make the recommendations set forth below at sentencing, which is to be set after the trial of Lawrence Jackson. The State agrees to request that the Department of Corrections house the Defendant apart from Defendant Lawrence Jackson.



Plea to 1 ^o attempted murder of Albert Lahai.	State to recommend life suspend all but 60 years concurrent.
Plea to use of handgun in the commission of a felony victim Albert Lahai.	State to recommend 20 years concurrent.
State to enter remaining counts nolle prosequi	

Car Jacking Case (CT020800X/CT021564X)	State to recommend that all of the counts in this case run concurrent to CT020847X.
Plea to carjacking.	State to recommend 20 y. concurrent.
Plea to use of a handgun in the commission of a felony (carjacking victim).	State to recommend 20 y. consecutive to carjacking, but concurrent to all other counts.
Plea to 1° assault of Robert Heverly.	State to recommend 25 y. concurrent.
Plea to use of a handgun in the commission of a felony (victim Robert Heverly).	State to recommend 20 years consecutive to 1° assault of Robert Heverly, but concurrent to all other counts.
State to enter remaining counts nolle prosequi at sentencing.	

The Court agrees not to exceed the sentencing recommendations set forth in this agreement.




