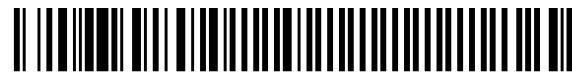

ADDENDUM TO PROOF OF CLAIM OF GRANITE TELECOMMUNICATIONS, LLC

Creditor, Granite Telecommunications, LLC (the “Claimant”) bases this claim (the “Claim”) against debtors The Container Store Group, Inc., et al. (the “Debtors”) on amounts owed to Claimant in connection with its contract with Claimant (the “Contract”)¹ dated 7/23/2020 pursuant to which Claimant provides the Debtors with telephone and internet/voice and data services at multiple commercial premises belonging to the Debtors. Copies of the Contract have not been attached hereto as they are already in the possession of the Debtors and they contain confidential information. Copies will be provided upon request to the Debtors, the Court, and the United States Trustee.

The Debtor’s failure to pay amounts owed under the terms of the Contract to Claimant through 12/23/2024 (the “Petition Date”) has resulted in an outstanding pre-petition debt to Claimant in the amount of \$84,155.37 (the “Pre-Petition Default”), as demonstrated in the following chart:
