Addendum to Proof of Claim of Fat Kid Deals, Inc.

In re Discus Dreams, Inc. Case No. 24-11991

As provided by Rule 3002(a) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (the "Bankruptcy Rules") and section 501(a) of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code"), Fat Kid Deals, Inc. ("FKD") files this attachment to its proof of claim (the "Proof of Claim") in the above referenced case.

On February 28, 2004, Thrasio Holdings, Inc. and Discus Dreams, Inc. (collectively the "Debtors") each filed a voluntary petition for relief under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code in the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Jersey (the "Bankruptcy Court").

On or about December 29, 2021, Discus Dreams, Inc. entered into that certain Asset Purchase Agreement (the "APA") with FKD together with the principals of FKD. Under the terms of the APA, among other requirements and consideration, Discus Dreams, Inc. is required to payout to FKD amounts over time in consideration for the purchase and sale of assets by FKD (the "Performance Payments").

To date FKD has received 1 of the 3 required Performance Payments under the APA. The second Performance Payment came due after the filing of the bankruptcy cases by Debtors. The Performance Payment due and owing by Debtors to FKD for 2023 totals \$1,350,000. The estimated Performance Payment using year to date projections for 2024 totals \$1,094,328.

To date, Debtors have not filed a motion rejection the APA. This claim is being filed to preserve FKD's rights in the event a future rejection motion is filed. FKD reserves all rights of setoff, recoupment, netting and similar rights under any applicable contract, statute, common law or equitable principle. At present, the full amount of such rights is undetermined. FKD reserves without limitation its right to amend this Claim to add such information in the future.

The principals of FKD who are parties to the APA separately reserve their rights to the extent applicable as parties to the APA to amend this Claim to also include any claims they may hold personally as a result of any rejection of the APA and Debtors.

¹ The majority of the APA is confidential. Non confidential excerpts are provided for reference but the complete APA can be provided upon request and consistent with the confidentiality agreement terms to support this claim.

This Claim is being submitted without prejudice to FKD or its principals' ability to and expressly reserves the right to file any portion of its claim as an administrative expense claim. FKD separately reserves the right to amend this Claim to include additional prepetition or post petition amounts that are unliquidated but that are or may become due after the filing of this Claim.

The filing of this Claim is not and shall not be construed as: (1) a waiver of FKD or its principals right to (i) file or assert a claim for rejection damages under section 502 of the Bankruptcy Code; (ii) file or otherwise assert administrative expense claims under section 503 of the Bankruptcy Code; (iii) file or assert a claim under section 365(b) of the Bankruptcy Code; (iv) waive any principals right to file or assert a claim under section 502(h) of the Bankruptcy Code; (v) consent to the jurisdiction of this Court as against FKD or its principals: (vi) waiver or release any rights by FKD or its principals to a trial by jury in this court or any other court concerning or relating to the terms of the APA or otherwise; (vii) waive or release the right of FKD to have any and all final orders or judgment in all non-core mattes subject to review by the U.S. District Court; (viii) waive any right to withdraw the reference with respect to any subject matter of this Claim; or constitute and election of remedies.
