Upon the *Debtors' Motion for Entry of Interim and Final Orders Approving Notification and Hearing Procedures for Certain Transfers of and Declarations of Worthlessness with Respect to Common Stock and Preferred Stock* (the "Motion"),² of the above-captioned debtors and debtors in possession (collectively, the "Debtors"), for entry of a final order (this "Final Order") (a) approving certain notification and hearing procedures, substantially in the form of Exhibit 1 attached hereto (the "Procedures"), related to certain transfers of, or declarations of worthlessness with respect to Debtor Thrasio Holdings Inc.'s existing classes of common stock or any Beneficial Ownership³ therein (any such record or Beneficial Ownership of common stock, collectively, the "Common Stock") and existing classes (or series) of preferred stock or any Beneficial Ownership therein (any such record or Beneficial Ownership of preferred stock, collectively, the "Preferred Stock"); (b) directing that any purchase, sale, other transfer of, or declaration of worthlessness with respect to Common Stock or Preferred Stock in violation of the Procedures shall be null and void ab initio, all as more fully set forth in the Motion; and upon the

First Day Declaration; and the Court having jurisdiction to consider the Motion and the relief requested therein pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334 and the Standing Order of Reference to the Bankruptcy Court Under Title 11 of the United States District Court for the District of New Jersey, entered July 23, 1984, and amended on September 18, 2012 (Simandle, C.J.); and this Court having found that venue of this proceeding and the Motion in this district is proper pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and this Court having found that the Debtors' notice of the Motion was appropriate under the circumstances and no other notice need be provided; and this Court having reviewed the Motion and having heard the statements in support of the relief requested therein at a hearing before this Court; and this Court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Motion establish just cause for the relief granted herein; and upon all of the proceedings had before the Court and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Motion is **GRANTED** on a final basis as set forth herein.
2. The Procedures, as set forth in **Exhibit 1** attached to this Final Order are hereby approved on a final basis.
3. Any transfer of or declaration of worthlessness with respect to Beneficial Ownership of Common Stock or Preferred Stock in violation of the Procedures, including but not limited to the notice requirements, shall be null and void *ab initio*.
4. In the case of any such transfer of Beneficial Ownership of Common Stock or Preferred Stock in violation of the Procedures, including but not limited to the notice requirements, the person or entity making such transfer shall be required to take remedial actions specified by

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the Debtors, which may include the actions specified in Private Letter Ruling 201010009 (Dec. 4, 2009), to appropriately reflect that such transfer is null and void *ab initio*.

5. In the case of any such declaration of worthlessness with respect to Beneficial Ownership of Common Stock or Preferred Stock in violation of the Procedures, including the notice requirements, the person or entity making such declaration shall be required to file an amended tax return revoking such declaration and any related deduction to appropriately reflect that such declaration is void *ab initio*.

6. The Debtors may, with the consent of the Ad Hoc Group and the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors, appointed on March 12, 2024 in the above-captioned chapter 11 cases (the “Committee”) (which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld, conditioned, or delayed) retroactively or prospectively, in writing, waive any and all restrictions, stays and notification procedures set forth in the Procedures; provided that the Debtors shall obtain the consent of the Ad Hoc Group.

7. The Debtors shall post the Procedures to the website established by KCC for these chapter 11 cases (<https://www.kcellc.net/Thrasio>), such notice being reasonably calculated to provide notice to all parties that may be affected by the Procedures, whether known or unknown,

8. To the extent that this Final Order is inconsistent with any prior order or pleading with respect to the Motion in these chapter 11 cases, the terms of this Final Order shall govern.

9. Nothing herein shall preclude any person desirous of acquiring Common Stock or Preferred Stock from requesting relief from this Final Order from this Court, subject to the Debtors’ and the other Notice Parties’ rights to oppose such relief.

10. The requirements set forth in this Final Order are in addition to the requirements of applicable law and do not excuse compliance therewith.

11. Nothing contained in the Motion or this Final Order, and no action taken pursuant to the relief requested or granted (including any payment made in accordance with this Final Order), is intended as or shall be construed or deemed to be: (a) an admission as to the amount of, basis for, priority of, or validity of any claim against the Debtors under the Bankruptcy Code or other applicable nonbankruptcy law; (b) a waiver of the Debtors' or any other party in interest's right (including by the Committee) to dispute any claim on any grounds, including, but not limited to, the right of the Committee to seek to challenge the characterization of any intercompany claims as equity; (c) a promise or requirement to pay any particular claim; (d) an implication, admission or finding that any particular claim is an administrative expense claim, other priority claim or otherwise of a type specified or defined in the Motion or this Final Order except as otherwise provided for in this Final Order; (e) a request or authorization to assume, adopt, or reject any agreement, contract, or lease pursuant to section 365 of the Bankruptcy Code; (f) an admission as to the validity, priority, enforceability or perfection of any lien on, security interest in, or other encumbrance on property of the Debtors' estates; or (g) a waiver or limitation of any claims, causes of action or other rights of the Debtors or any other party in interest (including the Committee) against any person or entity under the Bankruptcy Code or any other applicable law. The Committee also expressly reserves all rights with respect to the allocation of administrative expenses among Debtor entities.

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12. Other than to the extent that this Final Order expressly conditions or restricts trading in Common Stock or Preferred Stock, nothing in this Final Order or in the Motion shall, or shall be deemed to, prejudice, impair, or otherwise alter or affect the rights of any holders of Common Stock or Preferred Stock, as applicable, including in connection with the treatment of any such stock under any chapter 11 plan or any applicable bankruptcy court order.

13. Notice of the Motion as provided therein shall be deemed good and sufficient notice of such Motion and the requirements of Bankruptcy Rule 6004(a) and the Local Rules are satisfied by such notice.

14. Notwithstanding Bankruptcy Rule 6004(h), the terms and conditions of this Final Order are immediately effective and enforceable upon its entry.

15. The Debtors are authorized to take all actions necessary to effectuate the relief granted in this Final Order in accordance with the Motion.

16. The requirement set forth in Local Rule 9013-1(a)(3) that any motion be accompanied by a memorandum of law is hereby deemed satisfied by the contents of the Motion or otherwise waived.

17. This Court retains exclusive jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the implementation, interpretation, and enforcement of this Final Order.

**Procedures for Transfers of and Declarations of Worthlessness
with Respect to Beneficial Ownership of Common Stock and Preferred Stock**

**PROCEDURES FOR TRANSFERS OF AND DECLARATIONS
OF WORTHLESSNESS WITH RESPECT TO COMMON STOCK AND PREFERRED
STOCK**

The following procedures apply to transfers of Common Stock or Preferred Stock:¹

- a. Any entity (as defined in section 101(15) of the Bankruptcy Code) that is a Substantial Shareholder (as defined herein) must file with the Court, and serve upon: (i) the Debtors, Thrasio Holdings, Inc., 85 West Street, 3rd Floor, Walpole, MA, 02081, Attn.: Josh Burke, Michael Fahey; (ii) proposed co-counsel to the Debtors (a) Kirkland & Ellis LLP, 601 Lexington Avenue, New York, New York 10022, Attn.: Anup Sathy, P.C. (asathy@kirkland.com), Matthew C. Fagen, P.C. (matthew.fagen@kirkland.com), Francis Petrie (francis.petrie@kirkland.com), and Evan Swager (evan.swager@kirkland.com); (b) proposed co-counsel to the Debtors, Cole Schotz P.C., Court Plaza North, 25 Main Street, Hackensack, New Jersey 07601, Attn: Michael D. Sirota (msirota@coleschotz.com), Warren A. Usatine (wusatine@coleschotz.com), Felice Yudkin (fyudkin@coleschotz.com), and Jacob S. Carr (jcarr@kelleydrye.com), Maeghan McLoughlin (mmcloughlin@kelleydrye.com), and Connie Choe (cchoe@kelleydrye.com); and (vii) any other statutory committee appointed in these chapter 11 cases (collectively, the “Notice Parties”), a declaration of such status, substantially in the form attached hereto as **Exhibit 1A** (each, a “Declaration of Status as a Substantial Shareholder”), on or before the later of (A) twenty (20) calendar days after the date of the Notice of Final Order, or (B) ten (10) calendar days after becoming a Substantial Shareholder; *provided* that, for the avoidance of doubt, the other procedures

set forth herein shall apply to any Substantial Shareholder even if no Declaration of Status as a Substantial Shareholder has been filed.

- b. Prior to effectuating any transfer of Beneficial Ownership of Common Stock or Preferred Stock that would result in an increase in the amount of Common Stock or Preferred Stock of which a Substantial Shareholder has Beneficial Ownership or would result in an entity or individual becoming a Substantial Shareholder, the parties to such transaction must file with the Court, and serve upon the Notice Parties, an advance written declaration of the intended transfer of Common Stock or Preferred Stock, as applicable, substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit 1B (each, a “Declaration of Intent to Accumulate Common Stock or Preferred Stock”).
- c. Prior to effectuating any transfer of Beneficial Ownership of Common Stock or Preferred Stock that would result in a decrease in the amount of Common Stock or Preferred Stock of which a Substantial Shareholder has Beneficial Ownership or would result in an entity or individual ceasing to be a Substantial Shareholder, the parties to such transaction must file with the Court, and serve upon the Notice Parties, an advance written declaration of the intended transfer of Common Stock or Preferred Stock, substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit 1C (each, a “Declaration of Intent to Transfer Common Stock or Preferred Stock,” and together with a Declaration of Intent to Accumulate Common Stock or Preferred Stock, each, a “Declaration of Proposed Transfer”).
- d. The Debtors and the other Notice Parties shall have twenty (20) calendar days after receipt of a Declaration of Proposed Transfer to file with the Court and serve on such Substantial Shareholder or potential Substantial Shareholder an objection to any proposed transfer of Beneficial Ownership of Common Stock or Preferred Stock, as applicable, described in the Declaration of Proposed Transfer on the grounds that such transfer is reasonably expected to adversely affect the Debtors’ ability to utilize their Tax Attributes. If the Debtors or any of the other Notice Parties file an objection, such transaction will remain ineffective unless such objection is withdrawn, or such transaction is approved by a final and non-appealable order of the Court. If the Debtors and the other Notice Parties do not object within such twenty (20)-day period, such transaction can proceed solely as set forth in the Declaration of Proposed Transfer. Further transactions within the scope of this paragraph must be the subject of additional notices in accordance with the procedures set forth herein, with an additional twenty (20)-day waiting period for each Declaration of Proposed Transfer. To the extent that the Debtors receive an appropriate Declaration of Proposed Transfer and determine in their business judgment not to object, they shall provide notice of that decision to the Notice Parties prior to the deadline to file an objection set forth above.

- e. For purposes of these Procedures (including, for the avoidance of doubt, with respect to both transfers and declarations of worthlessness): (i) a “Substantial Shareholder” is any entity or individual person that has Beneficial Ownership of at least 2,552,875 shares of Common Stock; (representing approximately 4.5 percent of all issued and outstanding shares of Common Stock), or at least 4.5 percent of any class (or series) of Preferred Stock, as applicable; and (ii) “Beneficial Ownership” will be determined in accordance with the applicable rules of section 382 of the IRC, and the Treasury Regulations promulgated thereunder (other than Treasury Regulations section 1.382-2T(h)(2)(i)(A)) and includes direct, indirect, and constructive ownership (e.g., (1) a holding company would be considered to beneficially own all equity securities owned by its subsidiaries, (2) a partner in a partnership would be considered to beneficially own its proportionate share of any equity securities owned by such partnership, (3) an individual and such individual’s family members may be treated as one individual, (4) persons and entities acting in concert to make a coordinated acquisition of equity securities may be treated as a single entity, and (5) a holder would be considered to beneficially own equity securities that such holder has an Option (as defined herein) to acquire). An “Option” to acquire stock includes all interests described in Treasury Regulations section 1.382-4(d)(9), including any contingent purchase right, warrant, convertible debt, put, call, stock subject to risk of forfeiture, contract to acquire stock, or similar interest, regardless of whether it is contingent or otherwise not currently exercisable.

The following procedures apply for declarations of worthlessness of Common Stock and Preferred Stock:

- a. Any person or entity that currently is or becomes a 50-Percent Shareholder² must file with the Court and serve upon the Notice Parties a declaration of such status, substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit 1D (each, a “Declaration of Status as a 50-Percent Shareholder”), on or before the later of (i) twenty (20) calendar days after the date of the Notice of Final Order and (ii) ten (10) calendar days after becoming a 50-Percent Shareholder; *provided* that, for the avoidance of doubt, the other procedures set forth herein shall apply to any 50-Percent Shareholder even if no Declaration of Status as a 50-Percent Shareholder has been filed.
- b. Prior to filing any federal or state tax return, or any amendment to such a return, or taking any other action that claims any deduction for worthlessness of Beneficial Ownership of Common Stock or Preferred Stock for a taxable year ending before the Debtors’ emergence from chapter 11 protection, such

50-Percent Shareholder must file with the Court and serve upon the Notice Parties a declaration of intent to claim a worthless stock deduction (a “Declaration of Intent to Claim a Worthless Stock Deduction”), substantially in the form attached hereto as **Exhibit 1E**.

- i. The Debtors and the other Notice Parties shall have twenty (20) calendar days after receipt of a Declaration of Intent to Claim a Worthless Stock Deduction to file with the Court and serve on such 50-Percent Shareholder an objection to any proposed claim of worthlessness described in the Declaration of Intent to Claim a Worthless Stock Deduction on the grounds that such claim might adversely affect the Debtors’ ability to utilize their Tax Attributes.
- ii. If the Debtors or the other Notice Parties timely object, the filing of the tax return or amendment thereto with such claim will not be permitted unless approved by a final and non-appealable order of the Court, unless such objection is withdrawn.
- iii. If the Debtors and the other Notice Parties do not object within such twenty (20)-day period, the filing of the return or amendment with such claim will be permitted solely as described in the Declaration of Intent to Claim a Worthless Stock Deduction. Additional returns and amendments within the scope of this section must be the subject of additional notices as set forth herein, with an additional twenty (20)-day waiting period. To the extent that the Debtors receive an appropriate Declaration of Intent to Claim a Worthless Stock Deduction and determine in their business judgment not to object, they shall provide notice of that decision to the Notice Parties prior to the deadline to file an objection set forth above in subparagraph (b)(1).

NOTICE PROCEDURES

The following notice procedures apply to these Procedures:

- a. No later than five (5) business days following entry of the Interim Order, the Debtors shall serve a notice by first class mail and email, if available, substantially in the form attached to the Procedures as **Exhibit 1F** (the “Notice of Interim Order”), on: (i) the U.S. Trustee; (ii) Gibson, Dunn & Crutcher LLP, as counsel to the Ad Hoc Group; (iii) Morrison & Foerster LLP and Kelley Drye & Warren LLP, as proposed counsel to the Committee; (iv) the entities listed on the consolidated list of creditors holding the thirty largest unsecured claims; (v) the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission; (vi) the Internal Revenue Service; (vii) the United States Attorney’s Office for the District of New Jersey; (viii) the state attorneys general for states in which the Debtors conduct business; (ix) the registered and nominee holders of the Common Stock; (x) the registered and nominee holders of

Preferred Stock; and (xi) the Notice Parties. Additionally, no later than five (5) business days following entry of the Final Order, the Debtors shall serve a Notice of Interim Order modified to reflect that the Final Order has been entered (as modified, the “Notice of Final Order”) on the same entities that received the Notice of Interim Order.

- b. All registered and nominee holders of Common Stock and Preferred Stock shall be required to serve the Notice of Interim Order or Notice of Final Order, as applicable, on any holder for whose benefit such registered or nominee holder holds such Common Stock or Preferred Stock, down the chain of ownership for all such holders of Common Stock or Preferred Stock, as applicable.
- c. Any entity or individual, or broker or agent acting on such entity’s or individual’s behalf who sells Common Stock or Preferred Stock to another entity or individual, shall be required to serve a copy of the Notice of Interim Order or Notice of Final Order, as applicable, on such purchaser of such Common Stock or Preferred Stock, or any broker or agent acting on such purchaser’s behalf.
- d. To the extent confidential information is required in any declaration described in the Procedures, such confidential information may be filed with the Court in redacted form; *provided, however*, that any such declarations served on the Notice Parties **shall not** be in redacted form. The Notice Parties shall keep all information provided in such declarations strictly confidential and shall not disclose the contents thereof to any person except: (i) to the extent necessary to respond to a petition or objection filed with the Court; (ii) to the extent otherwise required by law; or (iii) to the extent that the information contained therein is already public; *provided, further, however*, that the Debtors may disclose the contents thereof to their professional advisors, who shall keep all such notices strictly confidential and shall not disclose the contents thereof to any other person, subject to further Court order. To the extent confidential information is necessary to respond to an objection filed with the Court, such confidential information shall be filed under seal or in a redacted form.
