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APPLICATION FOR PRO HAC VICE ADMISSION OF ZACHARY D. LANIER

Only an attorney at law of this Court may sign and file papers, enter appearances for party, sign stipulations, or sign and receive payments on judgments, decrees or orders. ORDERED that the \$250.00 fee required by D.N.J. L. Civ. R. 101.1(c)(3) for *pro hac vice* admission to the District Court for the District of New Jersey shall also be payable within twenty (20) days of entry of this Order. Payment in the form of a check must be payable to "Clerk, USDC"
