REMAINING ASSETS TO BE ADMINISTERED

The Trustee is aware of the following remaining assets yet to be administered for the benefit of the Estate:

- 1. A tax refund was filed on behalf of the Estate by Investment Recovery Group LLC, who were approved by this Court to act on behalf of the Trustee by Order dated December 1, 2020 (Doc. 3706). The tax refund is still pending and has not been approved or denied by the Internal Revenue Service.
- 2. The Estate is a plaintiff in multi-district litigation styled In Re: Rail Freight Fuel Surcharge Anti-Trust Litigation pending in the District Court for the District of Columbia. The Berger Montague PC firm is representing the Trustee by virtue of this Court's Order approving their employment dated November 12, 2020 (Doc. 3685). The experts hired by the plaintiffs have estimated the Estate's damages to be \$3.34 million. The deadlines for summary judgment replies and briefs will occur in December of this year. There is no trial date set in this matter.

3. The Trustee has been in discussions with several parties regarding the possible purchase of remnant assets. It is likely that the Trustee will propose to transfer the remnant assets to Warrior Met Coal, Inc. The Trustee estimates that the

remnant assets issue will be resolved before the end of the first quarter of 2025.
