**ORDER EXPEDITING HEARING AND SHORTENING OBJECTION PERIOD WITH  
RESPECT TO DEBTORS' EMERGENCY MOTION FOR ENTRY OF AN ORDER: (A)  
AUTHORIZING THE DEBTORS TO OBTAIN POSTPETITION FINANCING; (B)  
AUTHORIZING THE DEBTORS TO USE CASH COLLATERAL; (C) GRANTING  
LIENS AND SUPERPRIORITY ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSE CLAIMS; (D)  
GRANTING ADEQUATE PROTECTION TO THE PREPETITION SECURED  
PARTIES; (E) MODIFYING THE AUTOMATIC STAY; AND (F) GRANTING  
RELATED RELIEF**

The Court having considered the *Motion to Set Expedited Hearing and Shorten Notice Period with Respect to Debtors' Emergency Motion for Entry of an Order: (A) Authorizing the Debtors to Obtain Postpetition Financing; (B) Authorizing the Debtors to Use Cash Collateral; (C) Granting Liens and Superpriority Administrative Expense Claims; (D) Granting Adequate Protection to the Prepetition Secured Parties; (E) Modifying the Automatic Stay; and (F) Granting*




*Related Relief* (the "Motion to Shorten"); the Court having reviewed all pleadings related thereto; and the Court having determined that there exists just cause for the relief granted therein;

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

1. The Motion to Shorten is **GRANTED**;
2. The Court shall convene a hearing to consider the Emergency Financing Motion and all objections and responses thereto on **April 5, 2023, at 3:00 p.m. (ET)** (the "Hearing Date"); and
3. Objections to the Emergency Financing Motion may be made orally at the hearing, and any written responses and objections may be filed at any time prior to the hearing.
4. The final hearing with respect to the *Motion of the Debtors for Entry of an Interim Order: (A) Authorizing the Debtors' Use of Cash Collateral; (B) Scheduling a Final Hearing; and (C) for Related Relief* [Dkt. No. 118], currently scheduled for April 4, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. (ET), is continued to the Hearing Date.
