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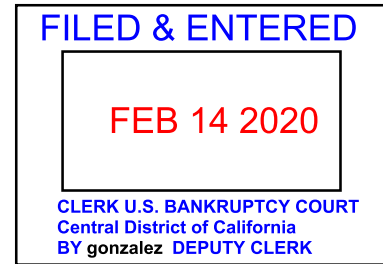


At the above-captioned date and time, the Court conducted hearings on *Strategic Global Management, Inc. 's Emergency Motion to Stay Adversary Proceeding* (the "Stay Motion") [Adv. Doc. No. 19] and the *Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors' Emergency Motion to Intervene Re: Strategic Global Management, Inc. 's Emergency Motion to Stay Adversary Proceeding* (the "Intervention Motion") [Adv. Doc. No. 27]. For the reasons set forth in the amended tentative ruling [Adv. Doc. No. 29], which the Court adopts as its final ruling and which is incorporated herein by reference, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:**

- 1) The Intervention Motion is **GRANTED**.

- 3) In the event the Committee wishes to be heard in connection with future issues arising in this action, the Committee shall file a further motion to intervene.
